

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OFFENSIVE INDUSTRIES

The Town Board of the Town of Sherry, Wood County, Wisconsin,
Do Ordain:

For the purpose of promoting the health, safety, morals, comfort,
prosperity, and general welfare of the Town of Sherry, Wood County,
Wisconsin, and its inhabitants:

No buildings, lands or premises in the Town of Sherry, Wood County,
Wisconsin, shall be used for the purpose of any of the following nauseous,
offensive or unwholesome businesses, to-wit:

1. Acid manufacturers
2. Cement, lime, gypsum or plaster of paris manufacture
3. Distillation of bones
4. Explosive manufacture or storage
5. Fat rendering
6. Fertilizer manufacture
7. Garbage, offal or dead animal reduction or dumping
8. Glue manufacture
9. Junk yards
10. Petroleum refining
11. Smelting of tin, copper, zinc or iron ores

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after
its passage and publication.
